

HOW DO I GET A LIBRARY CARD?

Regular and Bookmobile Account

1. Individuals ages eighteen (18) and over must have two (2) forms of identification to register for a library card:

- a. A Texas Government photo issued I.D (driver's license, etc.), United States Military I.D., or passport
- b. Digital or physical proof of residency (from an official document, such as: voter registration; utility or phone bill; insurance card; rental agreement; etc.).

2. Children can be added under an adult's account.

Teen Account

1. If a parent signature cannot be acquired, minors 16 and 17 years old may apply for a library card by:
 - a. presenting a government issued ID ALONG with another form of ID (such as school ID, car insurance, pay stub).
 - b. This Minor w/o parental signature account will be limited to 3 items.
