The Parker County Hospital District Telemedicine Program and **Lipan ISD** have a partnership that provides on-site healthcare to all **Lipan ISD** students and staff members.

With the use of Telemedicine and the MedPod Medical Cart, students and staff members may be seen virtually by one of our 3 Providers in a convenient setting in the campus Nurse's office.

Symptoms we treat:

Cold & flu-like symptoms, allergy symptoms, fever, ear pain, sore throat, eye complaints (i.e. pink eye), minor abdominal and GI complaints, such as nausea, vomiting or diarrhea, simple urinary complaints, such as frequent urination and rash or skin infection.

Testing available:

Rapid Streptococcal, Rapid Covid, Rapid Flu A & B, PCR Covid/Flu/RSV and PCR Streptococcal.

In addition, the Telemedicine Program also has a remote School-based Health Clinic located at **1115 Pecan Drive in Weatherford.**

We offer the same testing and resources that are available at the campus nurse's office. The Remote Clinic is a great option if the student is too sick to attend school, or if the campus nurse is not available.

This location is **by appointment only.**

This program is offered at **no out of pocket cost to students** and a \$25 flat fee for staff members.
